- your eligibility for hiring a live in nanny
- entering into an appropriate written agreement with your nanny (download our free sample nanny contract for information)
- obtaining a business number
- figuring out the appropriate tax deductions and other remittances for each pay period
- preparing an earnings statement for each pay period (download this free sample earnings statement for information)
- setting up appropriate payroll remittance payments to the government, and
- preparing a T4 slip and T4 Summary at the end of each calendar year.

Nanny agencies tend to handle some of the paperwork, but you usually have to pay for their services.
